Academie Imperiale Des Sciences	Commentarii Academiae Scientiarum Imperialis Petropolitanae. <i>A rare mathematical work from the Linnaean Library, with a MS dedication.</i> [BL.1223]	1747	£500
Clusius, Carolus	Exoticorum libri decem: quibus animalium, plantarum, aromatum, aliorumque peregrinorum fructuum historiae describuntur. <i>Linnaeus' copy of this important work on "Exotic life forms" from maybe the most influential botanist of the 16<sup>th</sup> century.</i> [BL.827A]	1605	£400
Lister, Martin	Historiae sive synopsis methodicae conchyliorum et tabularum anatomicarum. <i>Linnaeus' copy of a History of Shells by Martin Lister, the founder of conchology in England. The wonderful engravings thought to be the work of his then teenaged daughters, Anne and Susanna.</i> [BL.828]	1770	£400
Lee, James	An introduction to botany. <i>First edition of Lee's hugely successful introduction to Linnaean botany, which went through five editions. Lee was a gardener and nurseryman, and frequent correspondent of Linnaeus. This is probably an authors' gift.</i> [BL.328]	1760	£300
Lee, James	An introduction to botany. <i>Second edition of Lee's introduction to Linnaean botany, written for a popular audience. Again, another probable authors' gift from Linnaeus' library.</i> [BL.329]	1765	£300

Leeuwenhoek, Anthony van	Arcana naturae detecta. <i>Nature's mysteries lavishly illustrated by the "Father of Microbiology". The first depiction of "animalcules", or unicellular organisms, in print.</i> [BL.330]	1695	£200
Monnier, Louis Guillaume le	Observations d'histoire naturelle, faites dans les Provinces Meridionales de la France pendant l'anne MDCCXXXIX. <i>An important work charting the 1739 expedition along the "Paris Meridian" through provincial France. Monnier was a royal physician who contributed several articles to Diderot's Encyclopédie.</i> [BL.333A]	1744	£200
Kaempfer, Engelbert	Amoenitatum exoticarum politico-physico-mediciarum. <i>Pioneering natural-history-cum-travel-writing from Kaempfer's tour of central and east Asia in the late 17<sup>th</sup> century. Its descriptions of Japanese plants, recorded prior to Japan's closure to the West, made it the chief source of Western knowledge of that region for nearly two centuries.</i> [BL.311]	1712	£300
Gouan, Antoine	Flora Monspeliaca, sistens plantas [...]. <i>An important 18<sup>th</sup> century flora of Montpellier in southern France, from an "early adopter" of the Linnaean system. This copy from Linnaeus' library, in contemporary publisher's paper wrappers, contains a number of dried plant specimens.</i> [BL.270]	1765	£200
