Kongelige Norske Videnskabers	Det Kongelige Norske Videnskabers Selskabs Skrifter. <i>An early volume in the long-running periodical, in striking original 18th century pastepapers.</i> [BL.1218]	1768	£200
Academie Imperiale Des Sciences	Commentarii Academiae Scientiarum Imperialis Petropolitanae. <i>A rare mathematical work from the Linnaean Library, with a MS dedication.</i> [BL.1223]	1747	£500
Clusius, Carolus	Exoticorum libri decem: quibus animalium, plantarum, aromatum, aliorumque peregrinorum fructuum historiae describuntur. <i>Linnaeus' copy of this important work on "Exotic life forms" from maybe the most influential botanist of the 16th century.</i> [BL.827A]	1605	£400
Lister, Martin	Historiae sive synopsis methodicae conchyliorum et tabularum anatomicarum. <i>Linnaeus' copy of a History of Shells by Martin Lister, the founder of conchology in England. The wonderful engravings thought to be the work of his then teenaged daughters, Anne and Susanna.</i> [BL.828]	1770	£400
Kaempfer, Engelbert	Amoenitatum exoticarum politico-physico-medicarum. <i>Pioneering natural-history-cum-travel-writing from Kaempfer's tour of central and east Asia in the late 17th century. Its descriptions of Japanese plants, recorded prior to Japan's closure to the West, made it the chief source of Western knowledge of that region for nearly two centuries.</i> [BL.311]	1712	£300
Laet, Johannes de	Novis orbis seu descriptionis Indiae Occidentalis. <i>A difficult title belies one of the most important books of the 17th century. Johannes de Laet published some of the best early maps of the Americas, and his ground-breaking atlases contain the first appearance of such placenames as "Manhattan" and "Massachusetts". This copy is from Carl Linnaeus' private library.</i> [BL.802]	1633	£800
